


# SAFETY

## EMERGENCY - CALL 911



Fire extinguisher

is located inside the RV to the right of the front door.



First aid kit

is located in the cupboard under the sink.



LP, smoke, and carbon monoxide detectors are located on the ceiling of the RV.



Travel within the speed limit and in accordance with road and traffic conditions



Do not drive on dirt roads.



Always fasten your seat belt while driving.



Avoid driving in strong wind and severe weather.

# HOUSE RULES

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1

## SMOKING/ VAPING

Smoking or Vaping inside the camper is strictly prohibited. A smoke detector is installed. Upon check out, if smoke is detected the renter will lose deposit NO EXCEPTIONS.

## DRIVING SAFETY

Make sure all loose things are secured and do not leave them on countertops while in transit.

## KEEPING IT TIDY

Don't wear muddy shoes inside and keep it tidy. Flush only RV SAFE toilet paper ,which is located in the cabinet above bathroom sink

## REPORTING DAMAGE

Things happen, and we totally get it, but we ask you to report any damages and/or breakages in a reasonably timely manner.



# UNHOOKING FROM VEHICLE WITH SWAY BAR


Step 1: Use 4x4 wood blocks under tongue power jack (see red arrow) while vehicle is still attached to RV

Step 2: Raise power tongue jack up until sway bars can be slid off over groove, will take some force to get off.

Step 3: Once sway bars are off, lower the power jack until vehicle sits normally and unhook RV from vehicle.

Step 4: After unhooking raise power jack until RV is clearly above the ball, BE SURE chains and lights are unhooked before moving vehicle.

If additional help is needed for sway bars use the tool pictured below it will be located on the drivers side of the RV front compartment.



# LEVELING THE RV

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STEP 1: Once completely detached from vehicle, grab the small level located inside the cabinet above the sink and place on the floor of the RV as shown in picture.



Step 2: Lower or raise power tongue jack until the bubble is evenly between the lines on the level.

Step 3: Once level, go to the drivers side exterior compartment and find the panel for the RV jacks (see picture) extend jacks until firmly on the ground. If needed use leveler pads located in same exterior compartment.




# PLUGGING IN THE RV

Now that the RV is level, its time to hook up electricity, water and drainage hose.

Step 1: Plug electrical cord into red arrow.

Step 2: Screw waterhose into blue arrow.

Step 3: Attach drainage hose to yellow arrow.



## TOILET

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Lightly press the foot pedal (located on the bottom right side of toilet) to release water into the bowl of the toilet. The further you press down, the more water fills the bowl.

Completely pushing the pedal down will open the base of the toilet bowl and release the contents into the black tank.

**USE ONLY RV TOILET PAPER - WE PROVIDE IT.**



## WATER USE IF NOT CONNECTED TO HOSE

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Our fresh water tank has 47 gallons, but still you have to be very conscious about your water use when you don't have a water supply. To give you an idea, one shower at home a 10-minute shower would use somewhere close to 25 gallons.

**THINK FIRST THEN RUN THE TAB.**



## BEDS

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There are 4 sleeping places in the RV. Queen size mattress, dinette which converts into bed (To assemble read page 9.) Lastly, the bunk bed is perfect for kids but can comfortably sleep most adults (bottom bunk)



**Feel free to bring your own blankets and pillows, bedding and some pillows will be provided.**

# How to set up dinette bed


Step 1: Remove table top by lifting upward & removing table legs (watch your toes as table legs may fall out while lifting table top) see white arrows



Step 2: Once table top and legs have been removed the space should look like this. The table top should slip into clip ( see red arrow) The table top should sit flush on black stabilizers (see white arrows) legs can be stored underneath bunks



Step 3: This what the platform should look like once the table top had been set. Now remove side cushions and place them in your preferred order or as shown below.



# SETTING UP MURPHY BED


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Step 1: Grab the platform underneath the sofa cushions (see white arrow) pull up and out until couch lays flat.

Step 2: Unhook latches located on both sides of the bed (see red arrows) they may need a little shake to come loose. This may require two people for safety since the bed can fall down once unlatched. Make sure you're holding the bed upright while unlatching.

Step 3: Slowly lower the bed down, the wood panel at the front of the bed will be used as the beds legs. (see green arrow) make sure the panel is vertical

Step 4: See picture below for how the bed should look once its set.



# ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

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## CONTROL PANEL

Control panel is located to the left (walking into the RV) This panel will show all tank and battery level. You will also be using this panel to turn the on the water heater, porch lights, ceiling lights and extend/retract awning. Warning: Retract awning on windy days to prevent damage.

## TANKS MONITORING

The panel shows you level of fresh water and how much gray and black tanks are filled. Please be mindful of the tank levels. Black 1 is toilet, Grey 1 is sink and shower. See page 15 for emptying instructions.

## WATER HEATER

Water heater should be put on to electric if you have a power source. If you do not, have a power source it will be on gas. Otherwise, it should be lit up like picture to the right.

# AC AND HEATER

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## AC

Located on ceiling, blue fan icon will blow cold air and controls fan speed. Blue thermostat icon controls temperature.



## Heater

Located behind TV, before turning on make sure propane tanks at the front of the RV are on Use bottom lever to control heat temperature about half way will be warm enough.

# KITCHEN

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## STOVE

2 burner gas stove allows you to easily cook a proper dinner. Before you start make sure propane tanks are on. To light stove simply push, hold knob down and turn until you hear the clicking noise. You will have to use a lighter for this part since you will need to ignite the flame.

## FRIDGE

The fridge with freezer compartment take a little while to cool down. To make it more efficient, don't put any warm produce inside. If you aren't connected to a power source you can change fridge from electric to gas. The panel is located inside on the top of the freezer.

## SINK

Stainless steel sink. Please only dispose liquids down the sink drain as this can cause blockage.

## Microwave

Microwave will only run on 30 AMP power source.

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## 4-Foldable Lawn Chairs

Located at front passenger side exterior compartment.

## Children Entertainment


Small basket of toys located in cabinet above dinette.



# WASTE DUMPING

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The freshwater tank holds your clean water.  
This is the RV water tank that supplies  
water to your RV sink and shower.



The gray water tank  
holds the dirty water  
from your shower and  
sinks.

The RV black water tank  
contains wastewater and  
sewage from your RV  
toilet.

**DUMP WHEN TANKS ARE 3/4 FULL OR AT THE END OF A TRIP.  
FIRST BLACK TANK THEN GREY ONE - ALWAYS!**

1. Park near sewer drain. Close the RV's windows and vents to keep noxious smells and fumes outdoors.
2. Secure the L shaped end of the hose to the valve at the sewer line or dumping station. Next, hook up hose to the black tank valve on the side of the RV.
3. Pull the black water tank valve handle located next to sewer hose connection to empty the toilet waste first. Allow it to drain completely.
4. (This step only needs to be done on final emptying cycle.) Water should be off at this point, move water hose from normal hook up to water hookup over black and grey tank. Turn water back on and let it run until water runs clear. Turn water off and let remaining water drain. Once drained completely close black tank valve.
5. Pull the Grey water tank valve handle located next to sewer hose. Allow it to drain completely.
6. Disconnect hose from RV, lift it to drain any remaining water into the dump inlet and rinse by connecting to the dump station's water supply - NEVER USE RV FRESH WATER!

NEVER PUT ANYTHING IN THE BLACK WATER TANK OTHER THAN BIODEGRADABLE RV TOILET PAPER. ALSO, DON'T BE RINSING HALF YOUR LEFTOVERS DOWN THE KITCHEN SINK! REMEMBER, THE GRAY HOLDING TANK SYSTEM CAN GET CLOGGED TOO!

# BEFORE DROP OFF

1

- Take all your personal items.
- Double check that you've packed up all your belongings from bathroom, kitchen and beside beds storage.
- Remove all bedding and place on bottom bunk

2

- Empty the fridge.
- Wash all the dishes and wipe countertops. Cleaning wipes located under sink.
- Empty all the trash.

3

- Empty black and gray water tanks.



# DEPARTURE CHECKLIST

Retract the awning

Put away any loose items, close all the cabinets doors. Fold in murphy bed. Put down toilet lid. Close all the windows. Plug all drains back up with their respective plugs.

Turn off all the lights and the AC/heater and water heater.

Disconnect all the hookups (water, electricity, sewage) and remove leveling equipment. Retract RV jacks and turn off propane tanks. Fold up the steps by folding in the bottom step and pushing it in toward the RV. Fold in RV door rail/handle by lifting up and pushing it toward the closed front door. Lock doors.
